

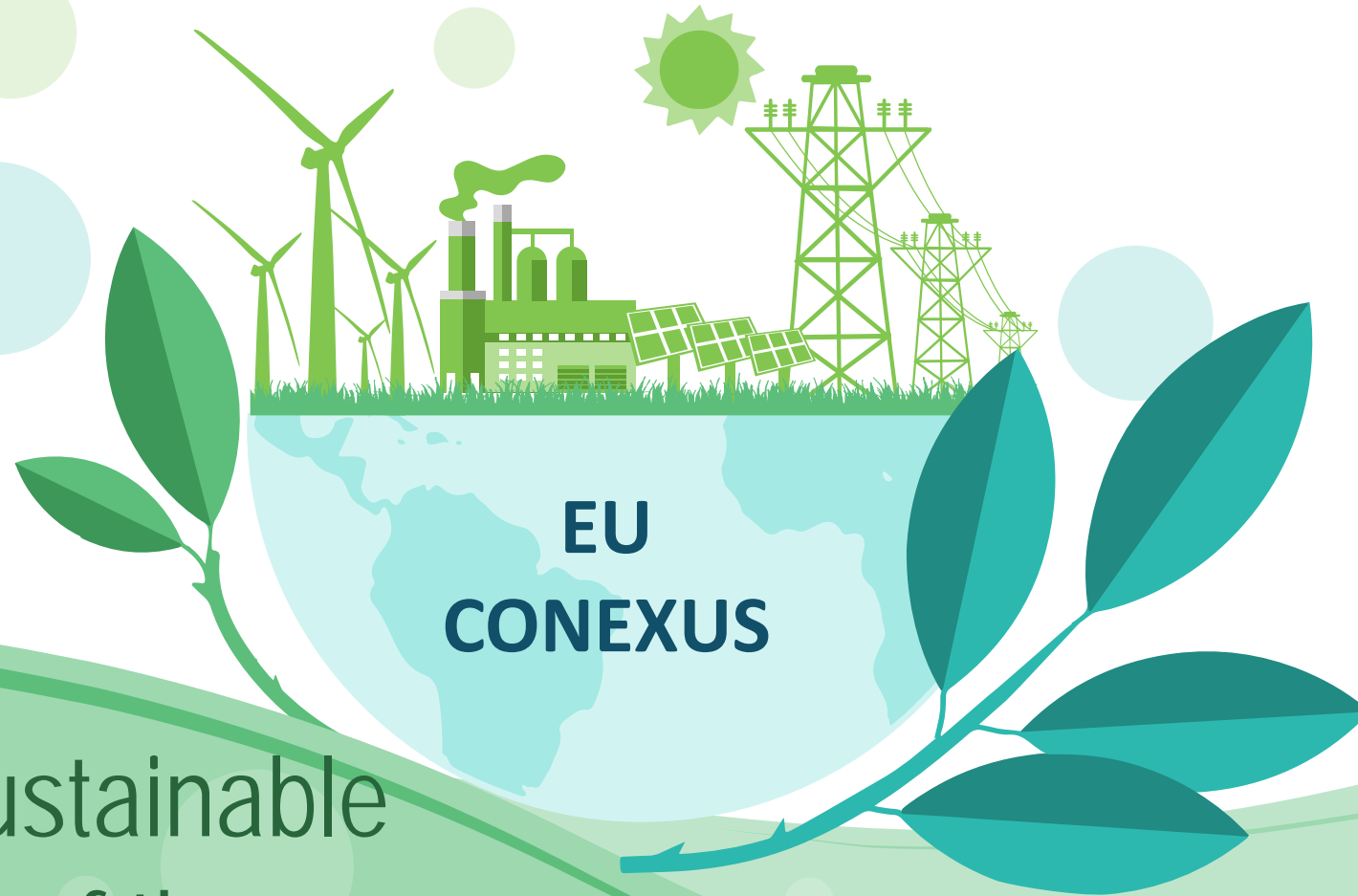

11. Do the problems of the coastal zone impact your day to day life? If so, in what ways? If not, can you imagine who is affected by them?

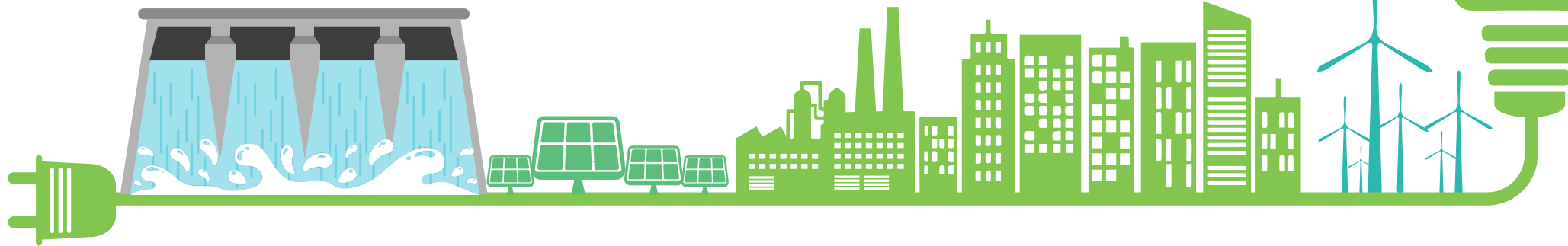
12. How do you envisage the coastal zone in a decade?

OUR COLLABORATION

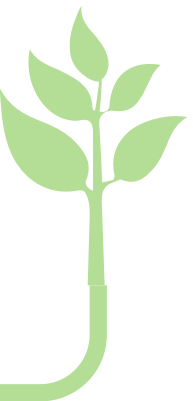
We believe that collaboration plays a very important role when it comes to promoting sustainability!

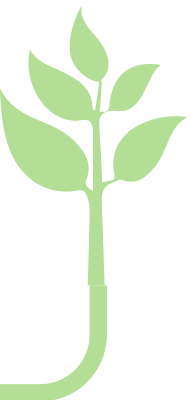
CONCLUSION
