Contraction of roads, highways, hydroelectric dams, etc.




### **O2** Population Growth

Climate change included events such as droughts.



#### Let's talk about the effects of deforestation

Loss of biodiversity

Forests house millions of plants and animal species. - 00

Disturbance in the water cycle

Dry air, low humidity, and decreased precipitation will inevitably lead to a desert-like climate.

Soil erosion

Deforestation decreases infiltration and leads to higher amounts of runoff



Disturbance of homelands and integinus communities

These communities rely on forests for their livelihoods and cultural identity.

#### Climate change

Trees play a crucial role in mitigating climate change by absorbing carbon dioxide by the process of transpiration.

Loss of medical resources

Forests are a rich source of medicinal plants and natural compounds.





#### **Economic impact**

Deforestation can provide short-term economic gains but in the long-run, it decreases ecosystem services.


